Victor, a Destination

History & Culture

Valentown Museum, built in 1879, was to be the shopping and community center of its day. Today it houses thousands of artifacts and heirlooms representing the area's rich 19th century history.

Ganondagan State Historic Site was home to a bustling Seneca Native American village over 300 years ago. The site now features miles of trails, a full-size replica of a seventeenth-century Seneca bark longhouse, and hosts regular festivals as well as Seneca meetings.

Shopping Diversity

From Eastview Mall, situated at the heart of a retail mecca in the Town's northwest corner, to the hundreds of independent merchants which dot the Route 96 corridor, Victor is an undisputed shopping destination in Upstate New York.

Recreation & Parks
